

# WELCOME

Dear Exhibitor,

I am pleased to welcome you back to the National Reptile Breeders' Expo for 2020. Your set up time will be Friday, August 21st from 10 am to 5 pm. You will be allowed in the exhibit hall at 9 am on Saturday and Sunday, which is one hour before opening for business. The customers will queue up in the air-conditioned hall that runs north and south between the west lobby and the exhibit hall while they wait for the Expo to officially open on Saturday at 10 am.



The covered parking garage next to the Ocean Center has a charge for exhibitors of \$10 per day. Overnight parking is permitted. These prices are for the pre-paid package that can be purchased on your arrival. For more information call the parking garage at 386-238-3110. You can also purchase the 3-day pass on set up day, Friday the 21st. Valet parking is available at the Hilton Hotel for hotel guests only. Outdoor parking at the Hilton parking lot is \$20 per day with overnight parking permitted.

All Expo activities will be at the Ocean Center during the day. Cold-blooded Creations, reptile/amphibian art show directed by Fred Ryder, will be in the NW corner of the exhibit hall. Expo evening activities will be across the street at the headquarters hotel, The Daytona Hilton. Please see the Expo website, [reptilebreedersexpo.com](http://reptilebreedersexpo.com) for more information. This year turtle talks will be held on Friday night at the Hilton. Our annual auction on Saturday night will benefit USARK and like the last few years also support several herp activities. The bulk of our fund raising, \$100,000 has gone to USARK. We will be contacting exhibitors requesting auction donations. All donations are appreciated

The entrance to the Breeders' Expo will be at both ends of the hall that runs north and south behind the west lobby. The south entrance faces the Peabody Auditorium and the north entrance faces the Water Park next to the parking garage. If you want electricity at your booth you must fill out the electrical form in your vendor's package and send it with payment to Production Elektriks. You do not have to list your booth as you are listed in the program which is available to Production Elektriks. **No batteries may be used to power lights or equipment per facility electrical codes.**

All exhibitors, The Cold-Blooded Creations Art show, ATM, all food sales, registration, official show tee shirt sales, government and non-profit groups will be in the one exhibit hall. Shipyourreptiles.com and Reptile Express will be on hand to ship reptiles to your door from the show.

I need your help in seeing that the hall is secured each night in a smooth and reasonable manner. When the announcement is made for non-exhibitors to exit the hall at the end of the day, please put your shut down plan in action quickly and be ready when the Expo staff request the exhibitors to exit the hall. At the end of the day everyone, exhibitors and show staff are tired so we need to work together to have a smooth exit from the hall. I appreciate your help with this.
