

DOCUMENTS THIS YEAR



The management of the National Reptile Breeders Expo (NRBE) has worked closely with the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWC) in preparation for this year's Expo. Our goal this year is directed at lessening the impact on vendors by streamlining the inspection process while still maintaining a high level of compliance with state law.

This year all vendors who will be displaying or selling animals will need to provide a **photocopy** of their expo inventories, FWC permit and health certificates (if applicable) to NRBE staff at check-in. You will not receive your table assignment until all required paperwork is provided. These documents will be made available to FWC staff for inspection/ verification. FWC inspectors will still be monitoring the floor for general husbandry and caging requirements.
